











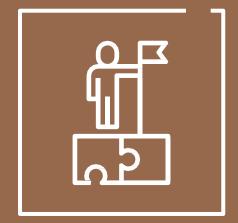






WHAT THE POLISH MEDICAL DEVICES SECTOR STANDS FOR?

Specialised equipment

Two categories account for the vast majority of Polish medical device industry's exports, namely orthopedic equipment, apparatus, prostheses, and hearing aids as one, and medical and veterinary instruments as the other.

In 2019, they accounted for **1 270m.** € and **962m**. € worth of exports, respectively.

The domestic value of Polish medical devices and equipment sector amounts to **2.9b.** € and it boasts **15% share** of all Polish manufacturers.

In 2019 it constituted **1%** of total Polish exports.

Excellent quality

Polish medical equipment and devices are known for their high production quality, low failure rate, low operating, service and spare part costs, high durability, flexibility in customer relations and order processing, compatibility with equipment made by other manufacturers, and excellent quality-to-price ratio.

Great scientific foundation

Physics, medicine, chemistry, pharmacology and pharmaceuticals, alongside mathematics, are the highest-ranking scientific fields in Hirsche index for Poland. Alongside a dynamic IT sector, this provides a fertile ground for development of medical technologies.

Through institutions such as NCBR, PARP or PFR Ventures, Poland also offers various forms of both financial and non-financial support to medical start-ups. In fact, 25% of venture capital in Poland was allocated to businesses from the Health Care sector.

DID YOU KNOW?



Machine learning in radiology

Polish BrainScan created a tool that aids radiologists in stating the preliminary diagnosis and minimising the risk of misinterpretation of test results. The AI employed by Brain-Scan makes the correct diagnosis in 9 out of 10 cases, whereas the scale of mistakes among radiologists can reach up to 15%.



Robot-aided rehabilitation

Cracow-based Prodromus is a manufacturer of rehabilitation robots and software, providing technology and equipment that can help children from all over the world undergo lower limb theraphy through robot-induced movements of six joints. The higher effectiveness of this innovative treatment is additionally matched by the fact that young children enjoy excercising with Prodrobot.



Extensive health sector

In 2019 there were 890 hospitals operating in Poland, providing access to over 166 thousands hospital beds. We also have a growing number of medical personnel – well over 90 thousand doctors worked in Poland, of whom more than 57% were women.
