

Record-breaking export growth

In the first quarter of 2021, a new record was set in exports of the automotive industry from Poland (EUR 8.55 b., +13.5% YoY).



Steady growth despite pandemic

In the first quarter of 2021, the production sold in the group of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers amounted to EUR 10.5 b. This is 11.2% more than a year ago.



Leader in Li-ion battery manufacturing

thanks to our strategic location, strong pool of skilled employees, good business environment and investor support from the government.



A large pool of qualified employees

The Polish automotive industry employs over 210,000 people. This gives us 3rd place in Europe after Germany and France and makes us a leader among the countries of the V4 group.



Over 17-fold increase in LI-ion battery exports

Li-ion battery exports increased from just over €218 mn in 2017 to over €3.8 b. in 2020.



Professionalisation of the drone industry

with high quality courses being offered by 90 training centers located across 44 Polish cities.

CAGR of top 10 largest car parts exporters between 2015-2020


(countries ordered according to the absolute export value for 2020 in this category)

Largest factory of electric batteries in Europe



Competitive source of suppliers across the whole value chain, record value of FDI projects in the automotive industry in recent years



Electromobility is one of the most important elements of the Polish **Government's Strategy for** Responsible Development, which estimates that by 2025, there will be a million electric vehicles travelling on Polish roads



As the first country in Europe, Poland has an operational infrastructure supporting unmanned aerial vehicle traffic management - the PANSA UTM system

Strategic location

Poland's unique geographic position allows for a quick and steady supply of automotive parts to major assembly plants and ports within the same day

Entrepôt to Europe

Poland lies on the crossroads of key logistical routes, including the important New Silk Road project



DID YOU KNOW?

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Poland is a member of the European Battery Alliance, which works to build a strong European industry in all areas of the battery value chain (raw materials, materials, cells, batteries, recycling).



In the last decade, the Polish automotive sector has recorded a 100% growth in sold industrial production. The automotive industry is one of the most important industries in Poland, accounting for 15.3% of exports.



Currently, Poland is the largest exporter of car batteries in the EU. In 2020, batteries were the most important item not only in exports to Germany, but also in exports to France, Belgium, Austria or Sweden. Exports of hybrid passenger cars and electric buses are also showing strong increases.



According to the draft of Polish Hydrogen Strategy, a minimum of five Hydrogen Valleys will be established in Poland by 2030. Each of them will become a center for research, development, improvement and education in the implementation of this technology in the economy.
