



# WHY POLAND

#### Unprecedented growth

Highest growth rate in the OECD between 1990 and 2019

#### Superb market access

40% of the region's total GDP and a gateway to the wider EU market

Max score for Macroeconomic Stability in the Global Competitiveness

## WHAT THE POLISH ICT SECTOR STANDS FOR?



#### Steady growth

The IT/ICT industry constitutes about 8% of Polish GDP



#### Stable labour market

The IT/ICT industry employing over 550 thousand people, of whom three quarters are employed in the services sector



#### Availability of highly skilled employees

70,000 students 12,000 graduates per year



#### Fast-growing domestic companies


The domestic market includes around 60 thousand companies, both Polish and foreign



#### **Growing outlays on R&D**

In 2019, ICT sector R&D expenditures amounted to 3839.4 million PLN increasing by 12.9% YoY

#### Polish ICT market value (PLN bn) in 2019-2025



Every year, the number of employees increases by approx. 6%.

According to Eurostat data, the number of IT/ICT employees in Poland exceeded 550,000 in 2020, which puts us in the 5th place in the EU.


#### We never give up

According to Developer Skills Report 2018, Polish programmers are among the youngest in the world, starting their adventure with coding at the age of 5-10




#### We are digitised
